Deuteronomy 8:18 (TNIV)

18 But remember the Lord your God, for it is he who gives you the ability to produce wealth, and so confirms his covenant, which he swore to your ancestors, as it is today.

Confession

Lord, thank you that You give me wisdom and ability to produce wealth. I recommit myself to the covenant I have with you through Jesus Christ and I open myself to the grace you are offering to produce wealth. I thank you that many will be blessed through me as I remain in covenant with You.

Psalm 37:25–26 (TNIV)

²⁵I was young and now I am old,
yet I have never seen the righteous forsaken
or their children begging bread.

²⁶They are always generous and lend freely;
their children will be a blessing.

Confession

Lord, I thank You that I am righteous through Jesus. I thank You that You will not forsake me nor will you forsake my children. My children will prosper and be a blessing wherever they go. Thank you that we are amply provided for by You. I am generous because I have no fear for myself or my family. You are faithful and I trust You.

Proverbs 3:5–10 (TNIV)

Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;

in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.

Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the Lord and shun evil.

This will bring health to your body and nourishment to your bones.

Honor the Lord with your wealth, with the firstfruits of all your crops;

then your barns will be filled to overflowing, and your vats will brim over with new wine.

Confession

Lord, I trust you with my whole life, I lean on You and not on my own understanding. I submit all my actions and attitudes to you. Thank You that You are making my paths straight. Lord, I look to You for wisdom and I shun evil. Thank You that You bring health to my body and strength to my bones. Lord, I honour You with my wealth by giving my tithes and offerings and being upright and honest in all my financial endeavours. As I give You the firstfruits of all I earn, I thank You that you will cause me to overflow with good things that I may be blessed in every way and be a blessing in every way.

Proverbs 21:20–21 (ESV)

²⁰Precious treasure and oil are in a wise man's dwelling,

but a foolish man devours it.

²¹ Whoever pursues righteousness and kindness will find life, righteousness, and honor.

Confession

Lord, I thank You that You give me self-control so that I don't spend all that I earn. I receive the ability to save money. In You I am wise and I pursue righteousness, and kindness. As I do this I thank You that all holes are mended in my financial world and no wealth is lost. I thank You that I am overflowing with provision because I am righteous, generous and kind.

Proverbs 22:7 (TNIV)

⁷The rich rule over the poor,
and the borrower is slave to the lender.

Confession

Lord, thank You that you will help me to get out of all debt so that I will be free to follow You in my finances as in every other area of my life. You set me free from any financial bondage as I follow You and handle my finances as You have told me to. I thank You that I will give to many but borrow from none.

Jeremiah 17:7–8 (TNIV)

7"But blessed are those who trust in the Lord, whose confidence is in him.

8They will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream.

It does not fear when heat comes; its leaves are always green.

It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit."

Confession

Lord, I trust you with everything I have. Thank You that I am like a tree planted by water, I am not upset or damaged by difficult times but my life is always bearing fruit. My life is filled with good deeds, right relationships and financial increase.

Malachi 3:8-12 (TNIV)

*Will a mere mortal rob God? Yet you rob me.

"But you ask, 'How are we robbing you?'

"In tithes and offerings. 'You are under a curse—your whole nation—because you are robbing me. ¹⁰Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this," says the Lord Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it. ¹¹I will prevent pests from devouring your crops, and the vines in your fields will not drop their fruit before it is ripe," says the Lord Almighty. ¹²"Then all the nations will call you blessed, for yours will be a delightful land," says the Lord Almighty.

Confession

Lord, as I bring my whole tithe into the storehouse of Your church, I thank You that You bless me in a way that overflows to many. Thank You that Your desire to bless me far outweighs my desire to be blessed. I overflow with blessings because You have thrown open the floodgates of heaven over me and my spiritual family. I thank You that You are not only blessing me but You are blessing my nation, my family and my Church family as I follow You in my finances.

Luke 16:10-13 (TNIV)

10"Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much, and whoever is dishonest with very little will also be dishonest with much. 11 So if you have not been trustworthy in handling worldly wealth, who will trust you with true riches? 12 And if you have not been trustworthy with someone else's property, who will give you property of your own?

¹³"No one can serve two masters. Either you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and Money."

Confession

Lord, I trust You to help me to be faithful with the little that You have given me. I also trust you to help me to be faithful when others trust me with money, work or relationships. I receive Your grace to be faithful and trustworthy in all I do. I serve You wholeheartedly and not money, and therefore You are entrusting me with great things both spiritual and natural.

Matthew 6:25-34 (TNIV)

²⁵"Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more important than food, and the body more important than clothes?
²⁶Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they? ²⁷Can any one of you by worrying add a single hour to your life?

²⁸"And why do you worry about clothes? See how the flowers of the field grow. They do not labor or spin. ²⁹Yet I tell you that not even Solomon in all his splendor was dressed like one of these. ³⁰If that is how God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today and tomorrow is thrown into the fire, will he not much more clothe you—you of little faith? ³¹So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' ³²For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. ³³But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. ³⁴Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

Confession

Lord, I seek first Your Kingdom above all things and thank You that You add to me all the things I need, and so much more. I choose not to be anxious for anything but trust You to provide for me. You, clothe me more beautifully than the most beautiful things in nature and you provide me with food and clothing in abundance. In all ways I am taken care of by You, therefore I do not worry about anything.

Luke 6:38 (TNIV)

³⁸Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you."

Confession

Lord, I receive from You the ability to be generous on every occasion. I enlarge the measure by which I give to You and to others. Thank You that You return to me more than I could possibly give. You are more generous than I have ever imagined – allow me to see that and to become more like You in this.

Romans 13:8 (TNIV)

⁸Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for whoever loves others has fulfilled the law.

Confession

Lord, give me the grace to pay all that I owe and not have or accrue debt. Lord, I commit myself to be content with what you have given me and not to live beyond my means. Thank You that Your love flows through me to others. I trust You to be free from all debt. Help me to prioritise this and bring great abundance to me so that I can do this quickly.

2 Corinthians 9:8,10-11 (TNIV)

⁸And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work...

¹⁰Now he who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness. ¹¹You will be made rich in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God.

Confession

Lord, Thank You that You are increasing my store of seed and my bread for food. You are giving me greater capacity to give (seed) and greater abundance for me and my family (bread). You are giving me wisdom to know what is seed for sowing and what is bread for eating. Thank You that You are enlarging my harvest of righteousnessand making me rich in every way so that I can be generous on every occasion and my generosity will result in many coming to know you.

Philippians 4:18-19 (TNIV)

¹⁸I have received full payment and have more than enough. I am amply supplied, now that I have received from Epaphroditus the gifts you sent. They are a fragrant offering, an acceptable sacrifice, pleasing to God. ¹⁹And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.

Confession

You Lord, will supply all my needs according to Your riches in glory. All that I have given, and will give, to others is small compared to how You bless me. I receive from You the grace to supply many with what they need because I know that You will always make abundant supply available to me. Thank You that You see all my needs, even the ones I don't know about and You take care of me as one of Your beloved children.

1 Peter 3:7 (TNIV)

⁷Husbands, in the same way be considerate as you live with your wives, and treat them with respect as the weaker partner and as heirs with you of the gracious gift of life, so that nothing will hinder your prayers.

Confession

Lord, thank You for the grace to live well with those in my family. Thank You that my prayers are not hindered because I am living in honour toward all around me. Bless my marriage, or my future marriage, and cause there to be unity and faith in how we approach finances together.
